

1.0 Tryouts will be held each year prior to the start of the regular season for Minor, Major, Junior, & Senior leagues of play (boys and girls). The purpose of the tryouts are to evaluate each player's skill level, provide a basis for deciding if a player is capable to safely competing in their next level of play, and provide all coaches with information to assist them in their selection of players for their teams in the draft.

2.0 For each team within each division, a coach or coach's representative will be required to attend the tryout and participate in the player draft for the division they will be coaching in the upcoming season.

3.0 Tryouts and/or the player draft for each division are held assuming a sufficient player count exists for multiple teams. If an insufficient player count exists for multiple teams, tryouts, the player draft, or both may not be held.

4.0 Each division will draft in the following order:

Note 1: Any player whose parent/guardian is coaching in the same division they will play is protected from being drafted onto any team other than their parent'/guardian's team.

Note 2: The Head Coach and Assistant Coach will be permitted to have their son/daughter on the team they're coaching.

Note 3: Any Head Coach or Assistant Coach having a son or daughter in the draft of the same division they will be coaching will select their son or daughter in the team's third and fourth draft picks, respectively.

Draft Round 1:

The team with the least number of returning players will draft first. If there are multiple teams with the same number of players returning, draft order will start with the team with the worst record in the previous season and progress through to the best record.

Draft Round 2:

Same as Draft Round 1, except, draft order will be reversed (serpentine order). For example, given round 1 order of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, then round 2 will be 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

Draft Round 3:

Teams with the least number of players will have two picks each round until the teams have equal numbers of players. If there are multiple teams with the same number of players at this point, the draft order will start with the team having the worst record in the previous season and progress through to the best record. Head coaches will select their son/daughter in this round.

Draft Round 4+:

Teams will continue to pick players until all players have been chosen. Draft order will proceed from the previous year's worst record through the previous year's best record. Assistant coaches will select their son/daughter in this round.

- 5.0 All divisions which have more than one team will hold a secondary tryout and draft the week following the sign up deadline for players only if there are multiple players signed up in their division who missed the primary tryout date.**
